One of my favorite things about this event is the line dance lobby where there is open dancing from morning until late night – all request – in a very comfortable area of the resort. There are cushioned chairs and armchairs and tables and there are amazing banners with funny captions about all the instructors installed on the walls around the room. Not only that, but there are great vendors selling shoes, dance supplies and equipment, jewelry, etc., and a setup so you could pick up breakfast, lunch, and even dinner and the food was quite good. If you didn't want to eat there, you could eat at one of the restaurants in the hotel from high end to a little sports bar area. If you wanted to leave the hotel, you could walk out the door and catch the monorail at a very reasonable daily or weekly price. Even if you wanted to take Lyft or Uber, you could go to the strip for around \$10. There are lots of shops in the hotel as well as Starbucks, a GREAT YOGURT ICE CREAM PLACE WHERE YOU MAKE YOUR OWN CONCOCTION. Can you tell I liked that part? LOL. One thing that is really special about this event are THREE SCREENS listing what is being played in each room, the lobby during the day, and all three rooms at night. You never had to miss a dance you wanted to do because the rooms are right next to each other.



Not only could you line dance but they had instruction in West Coast Swing, Cha Cha, Waltz, Country Two Step, and Patterned Partner classes with world renowned Instructors John Lindo, Tim Perez, Stephane Schneider, Jo and John Kinser, Tianna Miller and other Instructors and Choreographers! No partner needed. I noticed that the classes were quite full so there was a lot of interest in doing this. New this year on Saturday morning, "Shabbat Dance Workshop" hosted by Ira Weisburd. Learn easy Israeli dances that were choreographed to Hebrew songs or prayers from the Bible. Ira will be introducing Israeli Dancing to VDE Line Dancers! I watched this and it was a full class.

There were also technique classes for things like "Oops! I Variated" a/ka/a how to look good on purpose and a class on how to write a step description as well as other technique and knowledge classes. I thought that was a neat thing to have.

I liked that each day had a real lunch and dinner break so you could plan your day with breaks. There were also fun theme nights and some of the costumes were fabulous and fun. This year was:

There were three rooms to dance in the evenings – all request for all of them but one was more beginner; one was a mix of everything, and there was also one that was more intermediate-advanced dances and the instructors would come in and do a wall to refresh your memory. I think we all needed that!

Another thing they do at this event is a slot tournament especially for the attendees at the event and it is fun! There are also two FLASH MOBS to participate in and that is quite a spectacle for everyone in the casinos.
